

# 2019 EDC Continuing Education Credit Guide



Stamped cards (BINGO cards) will not be used this year. **Attendees must have their name badge scanned after each session** to record attendance (badges provided at conference check-in). Continuing Education Credits (CEUs) will be reported based on this scan and the information provided by the attendee when they registered.

## CEU Instructions

Refer to the **key and session grid** on the following pages to determine which sessions are approved for the organization from which you are seeking CEUs.

Minnesota Power will report attendance to the MN Department of Labor, Wisconsin Dwelling Contractors, and Building Performance Institute based on session attendance and information provided during registration.

**Make sure to have your name tag scanned at the end of each session to record attendance** for CEUs. Failure to do so can compromise the validity of your CEU credits. Make sure to wear your name tag at all times.

Minnesota Power will email a Course Completion Certificate to each attendee based on information provided during registration and the name tag scan for each session attended. A Course Completion Certificate is proof that you attended a course. Please keep a copy of each Course Completion Certificate for your records.

To obtain credit for sessions, attendee must indicate which credits they are seeking and provide corresponding builder or ID numbers when they register.

**Scanning attendance:**

We will scan the code on your name tag at the end of each session you attend to record attendance for CEUs. Make sure to wear your name tag at all times.

**Minnesota Builders:**

Complete seven hours of your MN Builder credit CEU requirements per day, approved by Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (DoLI). You must attend the 7:00 a.m. session to receive all seven credits. Minnesota Power will report continuing education credits to DoLI on your behalf. Your credits will be reported to DoLI based on name tag scan and Qualified Builder Number provided during registration.

DoLI has issued all Minnesota contractors and builders with a Qualifying Builder number (QB number) or a Qualifying Remodeler number (QC number). Please make sure to provide your personal identification number, **NOT** your business identification number. DoLI requires that you must use this number in order to receive credits for your continuing education classes. **Wisconsin Dwelling Contractors:**

At the end of each session have your name tag scanned to record attendance. Attendance will be reported based on scanned name tag and Wisconsin Contractor Qualifier Number provided at registration. Attendees must provide their personal identification number, **NOT** their business identification number. Credits will be reported to the Wisconsin DSPS based on name tag scan and the WI Contractor Qualifier Number provided during registration.

**Course Completion Certificates:**

Individuals will be emailed a Course Completion Certificate for each of the classes they attended. Certificates will be sent to the email address provided at the time of registration and should be received within one month. Please keep a copy of your certificates for your own records.
